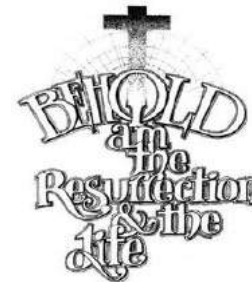

**Palm Sunday Blessing of Palms**

Leader: Fear not, Jerusalem! Your king comes to you meekly riding on a donkey.

**ALL: Hosanna to the Son of David.**

**ALL: Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.**

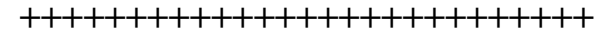
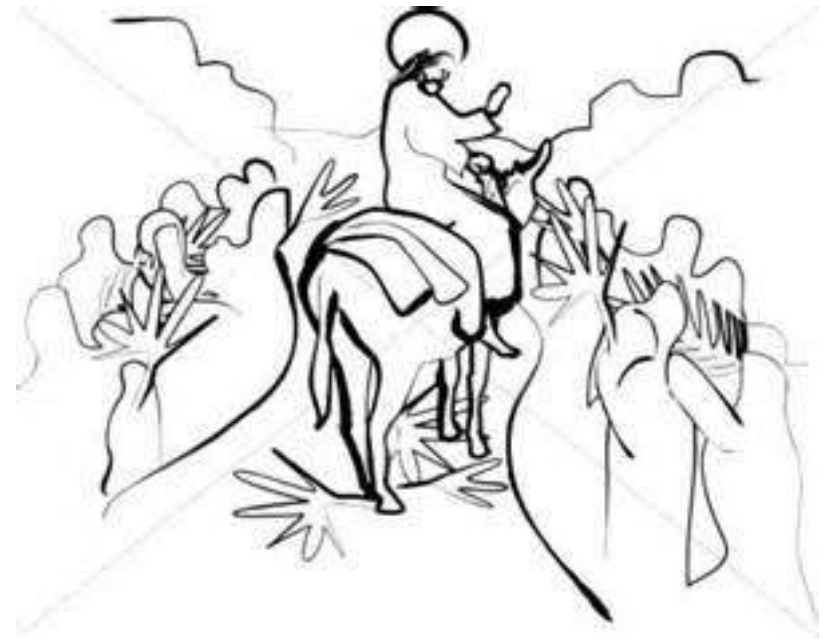
**Almighty God, who, in your tender love for us all,
